To encourage an interest in the subject area students may be brought on industrial visits (where possible and appropriate) to illustrate the importance and industrial applications of the module content.

Indicative Content

Sampling (representative) of solids, liquids and gases

Solvent extraction. Principles, KD, D, pH, ion association, chelation, continuous and multiple extractions, Ka, clean-up and concentration techniques, calculations.
